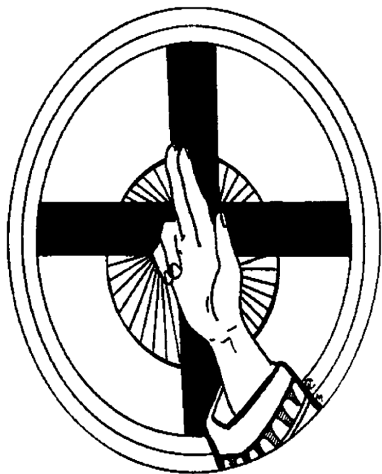

*Give it to the people to eat.*

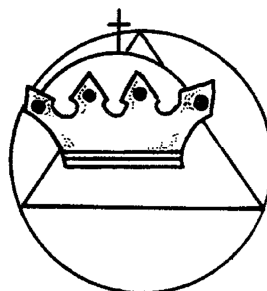
