RCIA: The Journey Continues

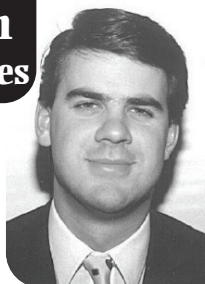
