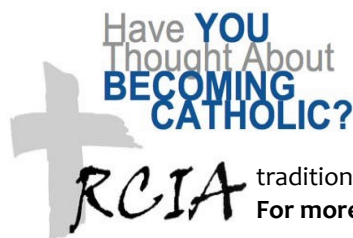

Office of Social Ministries

The Office of Social Ministries for OLMC is still operating and serving those most poor and vulnerable in the city of Newport News. These ministries have been serving in this capacity for the past 33 years and as we transition—those other agencies and Churches doing this work throughout the city—have stressed their overwhelming appreciation for the work that you at OLMC have done and are doing. Please help our volunteers continue this great history of service by stepping in where you are able. Donations to Parish Charities (Poor Fund) aid our financial ability to serve.

OUTREACH OFFICE

The Outreach Office receives those in need of assistance into our office 2 hours each day during the week (schedule listed above). We could use extra support interviewing, answering the phone or packing food in the pantry. If you have time & aren't sure if this is for you, please schedule a time to check us out. You do not need to have any prior training as the office is training ground enough. Contact the volunteer office at the number above.

Pregnancy Outreach Office

The Pregnancy Outreach Office serves those women in need with items for themselves or their children—up to 2 years. We could use support folding/bundling clothes, meeting with women, packing up needed items, etc. Contact a volunteer at 757-870-3131 to find out how you can help.

FOOD PANTRY

The OLMC food pantry is stocked 100% by the parishioners who go to Mass with us. Please bring 1 item to Mass with you each weekend. Each family giving 1 item from our list will be more than enough food weekly. We cannot do it without you.

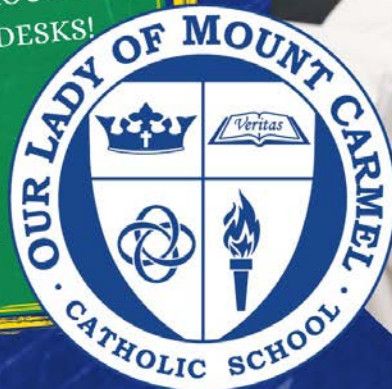
