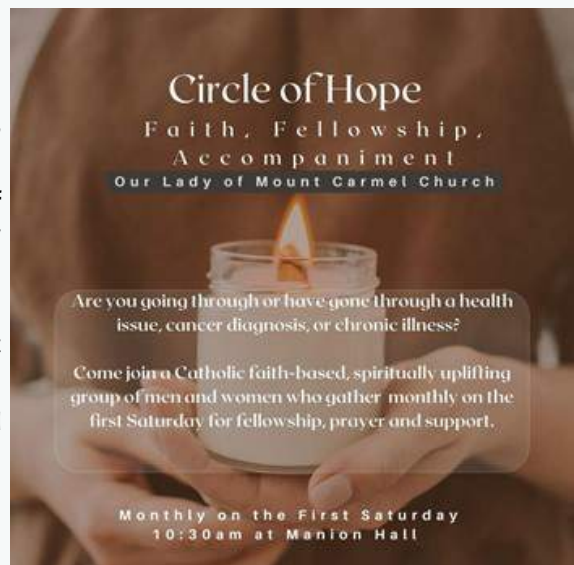
Are you going through or have gone through a health issue, cancer diagnosis, or chronic illness?

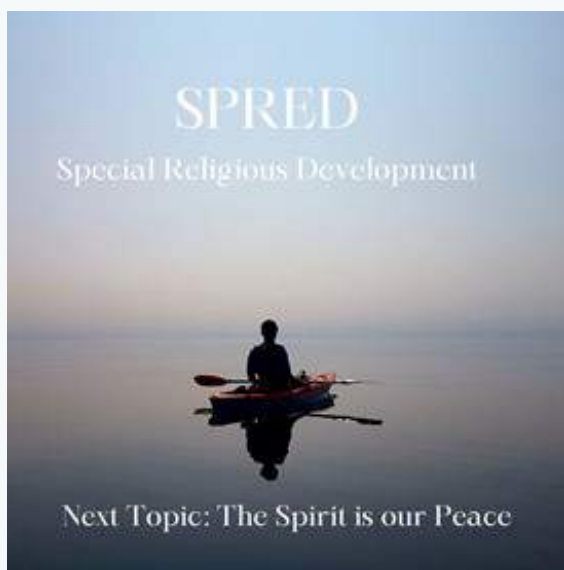
NEXT TOPIC: The Spirit is our Peace
