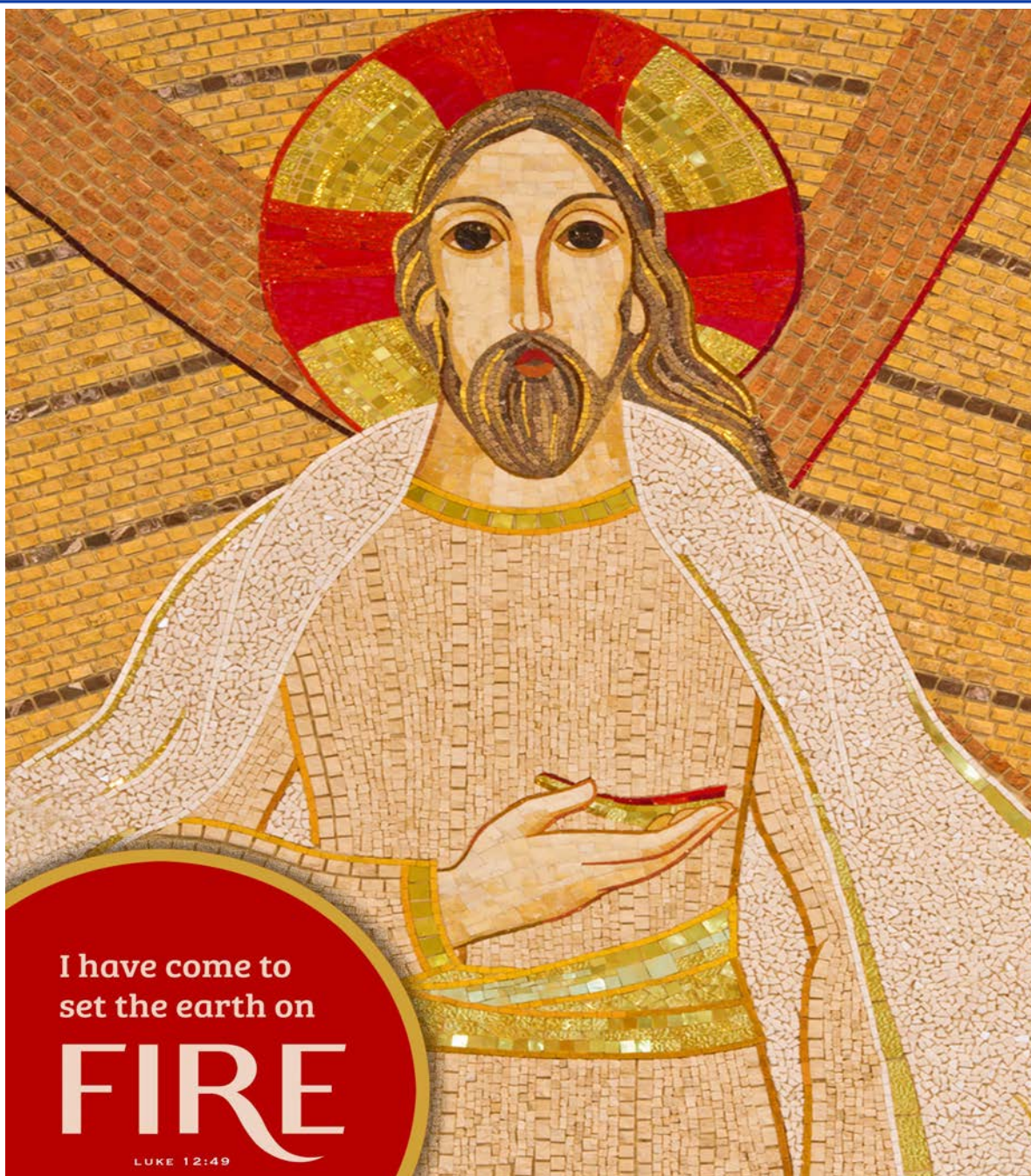

Office of Social Ministries

These ministries have been serving in this capacity for the past 33 years and as we transition—those other agencies and Churches doing this work throughout the city—have stressed their overwhelming appreciation for the work that you at OLMC have done and are doing. OUTREACH OFFICE

The Outreach Office receives those in need of assistance into our office 2 hours each day during the week (schedule listed above). We could use extra support interviewing, answering the phone or packing food in the pantry. If you have time & aren't sure if this is for you, please schedule a time to check us out. Pregnancy Outreach Office

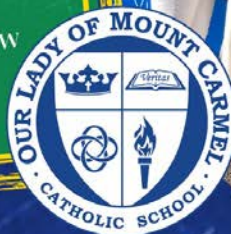
