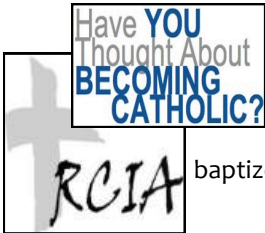

Initiation Programs and Adult Formation



The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish.

This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Would you like to feel more connected with your childhood faith or learn more about it as an adult? Consider attending the Awakening Faith Series.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The group meets once a week for six weeks of conversation and socializing. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God’s mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

The meetings foster reflection, prayer, and honest sharing in a setting of hospitality and acceptance. A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community. We can assist your return to the active practice of your faith and welcome you back to the Lord’s Table.

Following up on Father’s Flocknote of last week, OLMC is not only generous when asked by Catholic Charities of Eastern Virginia to provide Easter meals for our vulnerable neighbors. This parish lives out Christ’s summons to love our neighbors 52 weeks a year.

Over the first quarter of 2024, OLMC **served 705 people in 246 families** through the Outreach Office and Pantry. That is over **22 families each week** that come to our door: 22 opportunities each week to encounter Christ in one another.

From January through March, we distributed **456 bags of food** and gave **\$22,775.88 in financial assistance** for rent and utilities.

This was made possible solely because of your generosity — giving to the Poor Fund, donating pantry items and volunteering.
