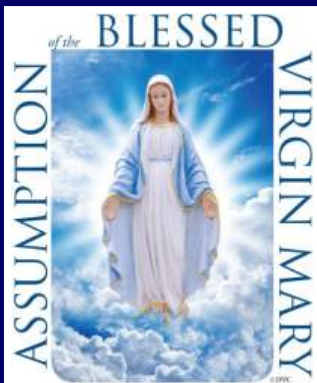

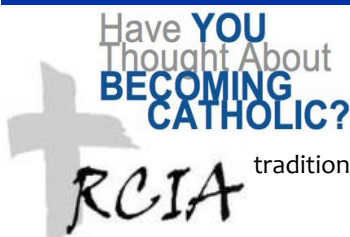

## Initiation Programs and Adult Formation



The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish. This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Would you like to feel more connected with your childhood faith or learn more about it as an adult? Consider attending the Awakening Faith Series.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The group meets once a week for six weeks of conversation and socializing. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God's mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

The meetings foster reflection, prayer, and honest sharing in a setting of hospitality and acceptance.

A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community.

## Social Ministry

### HEEDING GOD'S CALL

This weekend, we hear a small part of the last stages of Elijah's prophetic ministry. God called Elijah to reestablish His covenant and call the Israelites back to pure faith. This is the same covenant that God gave to Israel through Moses on Mt. Sinai (a/k/a Mt. Horeb). After Elijah spectacularly defeated the 400 prophets of Baal in a barbecue showdown over whose God was real (read 1 Kings 18), and then killed them all, Jezebel threatened to kill Elijah the next day. That was too much for Elijah; he fled out into the desert, laid down under a broom tree and told God "This is enough, O Lord! Take my life." Twice that night an angel woke him and told him to eat and drink. Elijah then went on a 40 day journey back to the mountain where God established His covenant in order to present his complaints to God. We then pick up with today's first reading. Elijah hears the tiny whisper of God's presence, and after detailing his complaints to God, God calls him to go forth again. And Elijah obeys.

**Please listen to see if God is calling you.** The Outreach Ministry needs volunteers. Outreach's financial assistance ministry and pantry are open 5 days a week. On Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, we are open from noon until 2. On Tuesday and Friday, we are open from 9 until 11.

We need volunteers to man the phone. This person is the voice of Outreach to our clients. They talk with people who call seeking assistance, schedule appointments, advice the clients of other available resources and then call the client to inform them of the decision on their application.

We need interviewers. When clients come to us, a volunteer does a 30 minute intake interview and then fills out an application for that client.

Both of these positions offer extraordinary opportunities to encounter Christ, to share in the joys and travails of our clients, and to advocate for them.

Please prayerfully ask God if He is calling you to join us. Ask anyone of the Outreach volunteers and they will tell you what a blessing this ministry is to them.

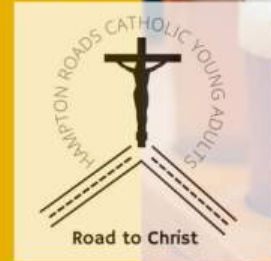

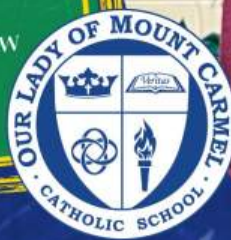
