

## Initiation Programs and Adult Formation



Are you or anyone you know interested in exploring the Catholic Church as your church home? Have you been sitting in the pew next to your Catholic spouse for years wondering what you have to do to become Catholic? If so, join us for a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish.

This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Would you like to feel more connected with your childhood faith or learn more about it as an adult? Consider attending the Awakening Faith Series.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The group meets once a week for six weeks of conversation and socializing. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God's mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

The meetings foster reflection, prayer, and honest sharing in a setting of hospitality and acceptance. A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community. We can assist your return to the active practice of your faith and welcome you back to the Lord's Table.



OLMC consistently lives out Christ's summons to love our neighbors - 52 weeks a year.

Over the first half of 2024, OLMC parish has served:  
**1,388** people in **485** families in our Outreach and Food Pantry.

On average we serve about **20 families** per week. From January through June, we distributed **887** bags of food and gave **\$47,933.34** in financial assistance for rent and utilities.

This was made possible solely because of your generosity - giving to the Poor Fund, donating pantry items and volunteering.
