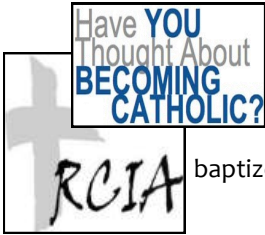

Initiation Programs and Adult Formation



The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish.

This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Would you like to feel more connected with your childhood faith or learn more about it as an adult? Consider attending the Awakening Faith Series.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The group meets once a week for six weeks of conversation and socializing. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God’s mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

The meetings foster reflection, prayer, and honest sharing in a setting of hospitality and acceptance. A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community. We can assist your return to the active practice of your faith and welcome you back to the Lord’s Table.

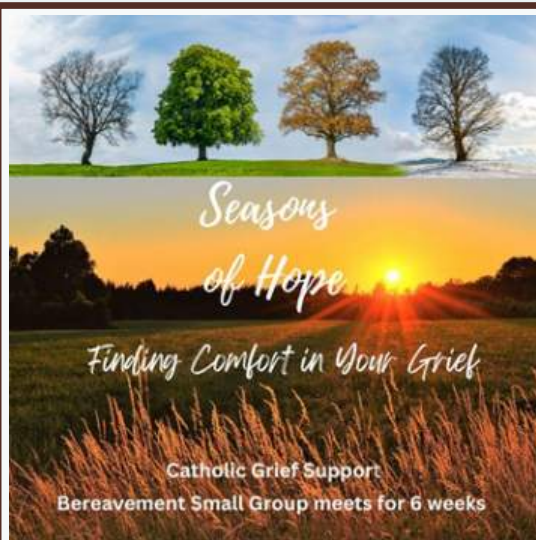
Seasons of Hope – Catholic Grief Support 6-week series Register for the next series online or call the parish office.

Quite a lot has been happening in Outreach, with lots of reasons to be grateful.

First an overdue "Thank you" to the Ladies of Carmel for their donation of \$1,000 to help us purchase hams for the Easter Bags. With a little judicious bargain shopping, we have enough left over to purchase hamburgers and hot dogs for the Fourth of July bags.

The Pregnancy Outreach received a wonderful donation from the Peninsula Angel Quilters (no, that is not a rock band). This fun group make quilts for children in distress. They donated 10 quilts to Pregnancy Outreach; we will give them as first birthday presents. This is not a one-time gift: the Quilters would like to be a regular benefactor.

The Church recently received a donation from a former client of the Outreach Office, with a note stating: "Thank you so much for assisting me in my time of need. I am donating \$150 to God's work." It is very gratifying when our clients know that this is God's work, not just another aid agency.

Thank you to the students in the first communion class, who generously donated lots of food to the pantry. That was good, because our shelves were almost bare after a couple of weeks of heavy demand on the Pantry - in two weeks, we gave out 122 bags of food.
