Initiation Programs and Adult Formation



The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish. This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The group meets once a week for six weeks of conversation and socializing. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God’s mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

The meetings foster reflection, prayer, and honest sharing in a setting of hospitality and acceptance. A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community.

POSSIBLE TERMINATION OF MEDICAID COVERAGE

During COVID, Virginia did not require Medicaid recipients to annually renew their eligibility. That has now changed. Over the next year, individuals who currently have Medicaid coverage will be required to re-establish their eligibility. The state will send a notice when it is that person's time to do so. If one fails to respond to the notice they will lose Medicaid coverage.

If you or someone you know has Medicaid, please make sure that you provide the State with your current contact information: call Cover Virginia 1-855-242-8282, or go online to commonhelp.virginia.gov or contact your local Department of Social Services. You should also promptly respond to any notice regarding this.

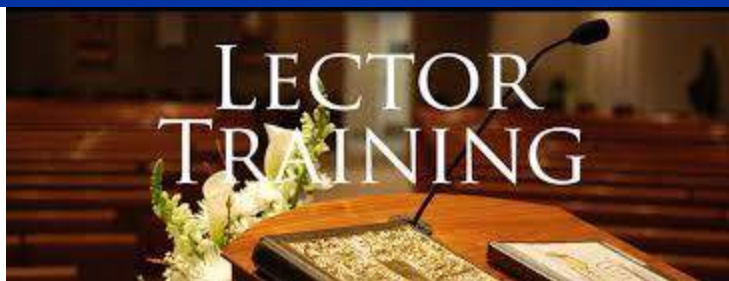


