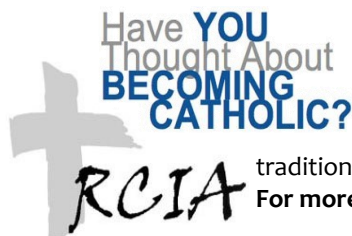

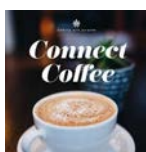

Nourished by the Bread of Life, we love our neighbor in word and deed.

Your Love in Action

You are a phenomenally generous parish: cheerfully offering your time, talents, financial resources, and an occasional can of green beans. In October, we were able to assist 76 families: 101 adults and 91 children, thanks to you. We gave \$8,099.72 in financial assistance: \$7,559.72 for utilities and \$540 for rent. We equipped expecting and new mothers with baby gear and formula valued at \$3,260. We distributed 118 bags of food and personal items, valued at \$3,396. All of this was made possible by your offerings to the Poor Fund and your donations of food and other products.

Yet, none of this could have happened without your selfless gift of time. OLMC's social ministries are conducted entirely by volunteers, with only one staff member coordinating their efforts. Come join us. We occasionally have parties.

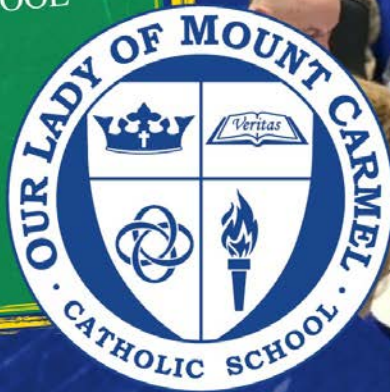

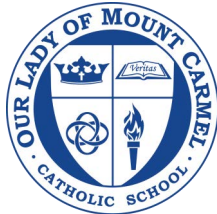
