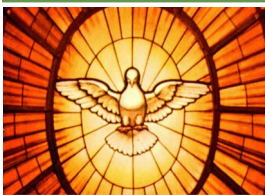


Are you or anyone you know interested in exploring the Catholic Church as your church home?

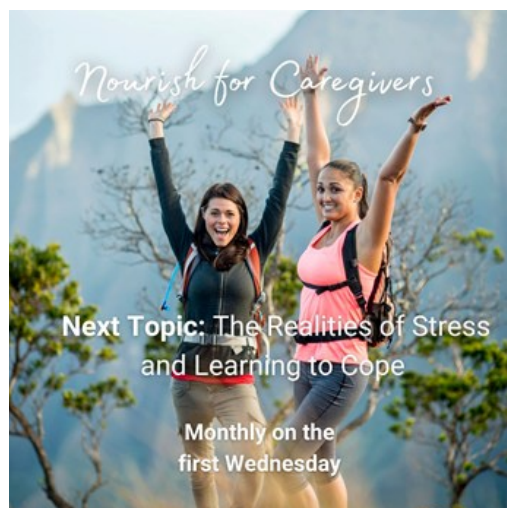

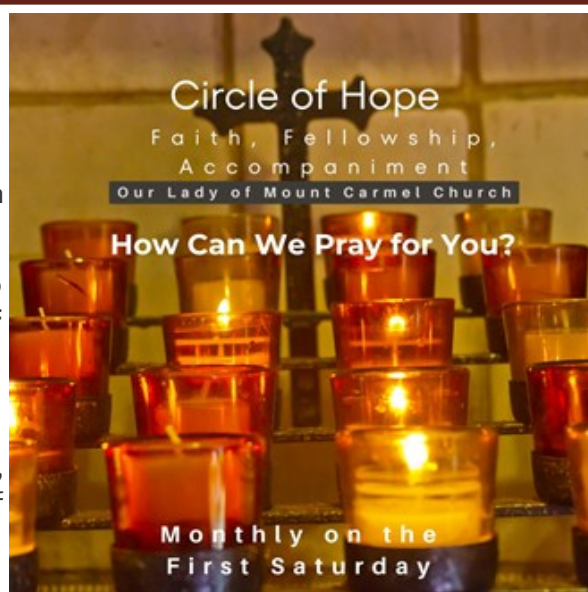
How can we pray for you?

We place our trust in Jesus and Our Blessed Mother, Mary, and look to the Saints who give us a perfect example of how to persevere during difficult times.



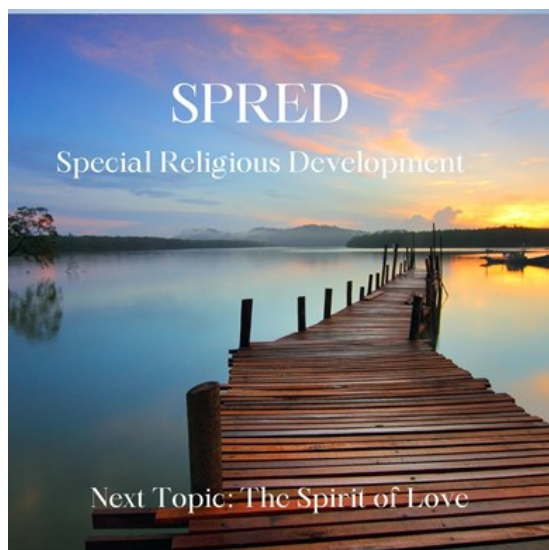
SPRED: Special Religious Development

PORT WRAP-UP

PORT, **P**eople **O**ffering **R**esources **T**ogether, has ended its program of feeding and sheltering the homeless for this year. The needs of our homeless brothers and sisters have not.

PORT's shelter services extend over 20 weeks during Fall and Winter. The PORT season usually starts the first week of November and ends the last full week of March.

A PORT week starts on a Wednesday evening, when guests are given a hot meal, a safe and warm place to sleep, and warm clothes. Guests typically arrive at 6:30 p.m. (5:30 p.m. when it is really cold) and leave the next morning between 4:30 and 6 a.m.

One church will host PORT for a week or two; other churches partner with them for one night during that week, and provide meals, volunteers and breakfast/lunch bags. This year there were 61 churches charitable organizations and businesses who participated in PORT. OLMC was a partner church on seven nights during the season.

This cold, long Winter saw the number of PORT guests significantly increase. This season, over 900 individuals were served by PORT, including women and children. One night there were 150 guests; last year's high mark was 110.
