Las clases de bautismo se llevan a cabo en el Salón San Miguel de 9:30 a 11:30 horas en las siguientes fechas:

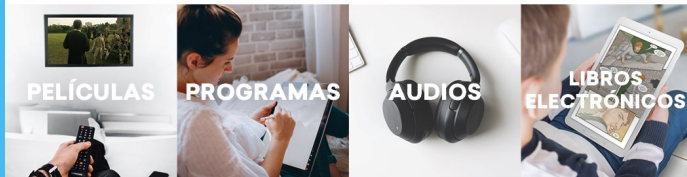

The Holy Family is joyous example of how families can thrive despite really adverse circumstances. Reflecting on the Holy Family brings to mind two families who have come through Pregnancy Outreach recently.

A young couple came to us when the mother was released from the hospital, having had twins. These were her first children. Of course they needed everything we had to offer to them, doubled. But what really struck our hearts was how young they were and their anxiety about how to care for and raise an infant (or two). Fortunately, most Pregnancy Outreach volunteers are experienced mothers and grandmothers. Wise women bearing gifts that came from your hands.

The second family was headed by a single mother who was between housing. She had four lovely older children (between 5 and 12), and now had an infant. She needed to start all over again, having no baby gear at all. In addition, her family was split between two apartments as they were waiting for the new apartment.

All are welcome.



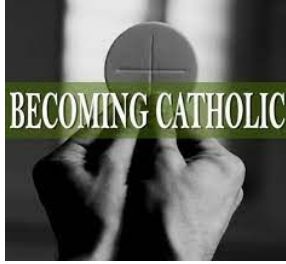
Nourish for Caregivers –Meets at 5:30pm on Wednesday, January 8 NEXT TOPIC: Staying Organized and Preparing for What’s Next

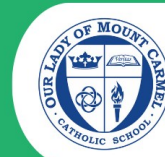
