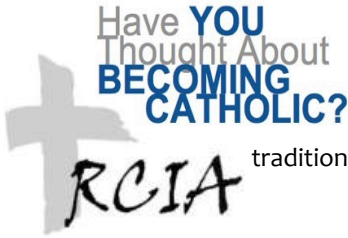

## Initiation Programs and Adult Formation



The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish. This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

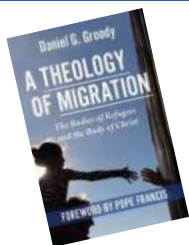
### FEED THE POOR

**“Amen, I say to you, whatever you [sheep] did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me... Amen, I say to you [goats], what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me. And these [selfish goats] will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous [sheep] to eternal life.”** Mt 25:40, 45-46.

Thank you to all who heeded the pantry distress call last week. Things are looking better, but we are still too low. The things we need most are **rice, boxed potatoes, cereal and canned fruits, vegetables and chicken.** Please make a habit of bringing something for the pantry every week. It is YOU who are feeding our neighbors — the food they receive comes from you. Some of you say you often buy something for the pantry but forget to bring it to Mass on the weekend. You may drop it off at the Church any day of the week: the doors are open and the bins are waiting.

Thank you. As has been said many times, Our Lady of Mount Carmel is an extremely generous parish. From January to June 2023, the Outreach Office helped 1,219 people in 417 families pay delinquent utilities in the amount of \$32,143 and pay \$3,503 toward their next month's rent. The Pantry served 252 families. Pregnancy Outreach served 125 families. This does not include your generosity to those families who received food, personal products and cleaning supplies for Easter and the Fourth of July. It is YOU who serve these families, through your donations to the Poor Fund and your donations of food, diapers, etc.
