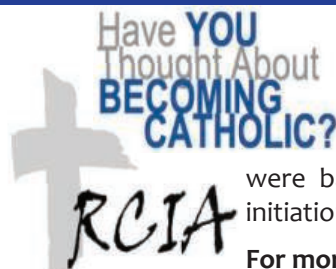

The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish.

This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God’s mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community. ### Walking with Purpose



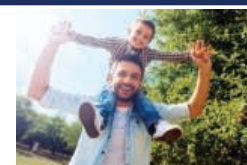

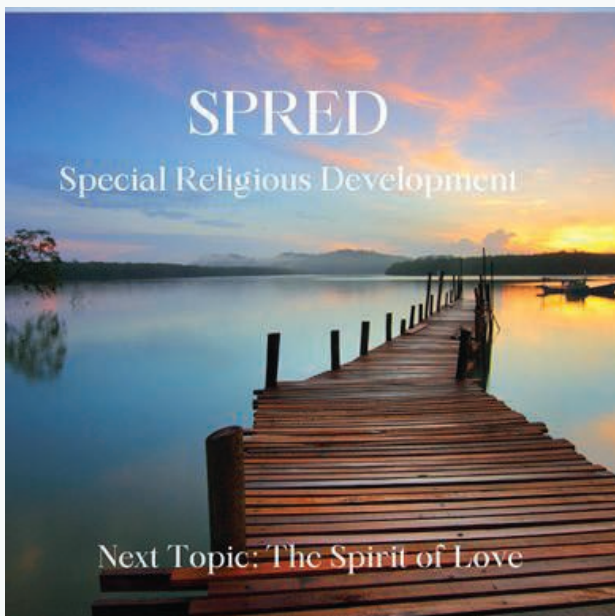
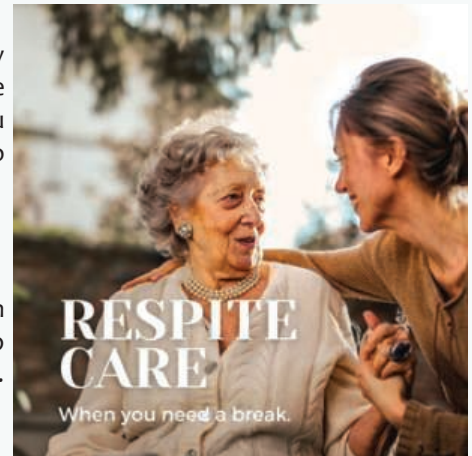
### When you need a break. The Respite Ministry is there to help.

If you are a full-time caretaker of a home-bound loved one, call the parish office to inquire about Respite Care.

## Social Ministry

### Extraordinary Generosity in Ordinary Time A Peek into the Pantry

Our wonderful ministry of feeding the hungry — one of the great corporal works of mercy — requires many hands. First and foremost are your hands when you bring food for the pantry and teach your children to do the same. Yours also when you give to the Poor Fund.

Next, that food must get from the church commons into bags handed to our neighbors. Enter the Pantry Sorters. Each weekend, one of five families on a rotating basis gather the food, sort it and shelve it in the pantry. Sometimes, they find an interesting offering — such as a can of green jackfruit or a jar of marinated artichoke hearts. While these delicacies may delight the palate of some, they are not part of our regular stock. Nothing is wasted though.

The interesting offerings, along with food in damaged packaging and food past its expiration date, are put on a shelf in Outreach's waiting room, with an appropriate sign. Our clients are encouraged to take whatever they might want. [The green jackfruit waited 3 months for a home.]

The Pantry Baggers have the privilege of filling bags for our clients. Taking into account the number and age of adults and children, and any health concerns, they fill the bags with food, as well as information regarding other available resources. We serve our neighbors who have made appointments, five days a week for two hours each day. After the client has had a brief intake interview by an Outreach volunteer, the Pantry Bagger assists them taking the food to their transportation.

From your hands to their pantries. Thank you.

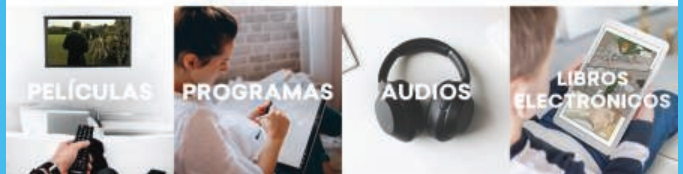

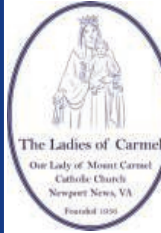
