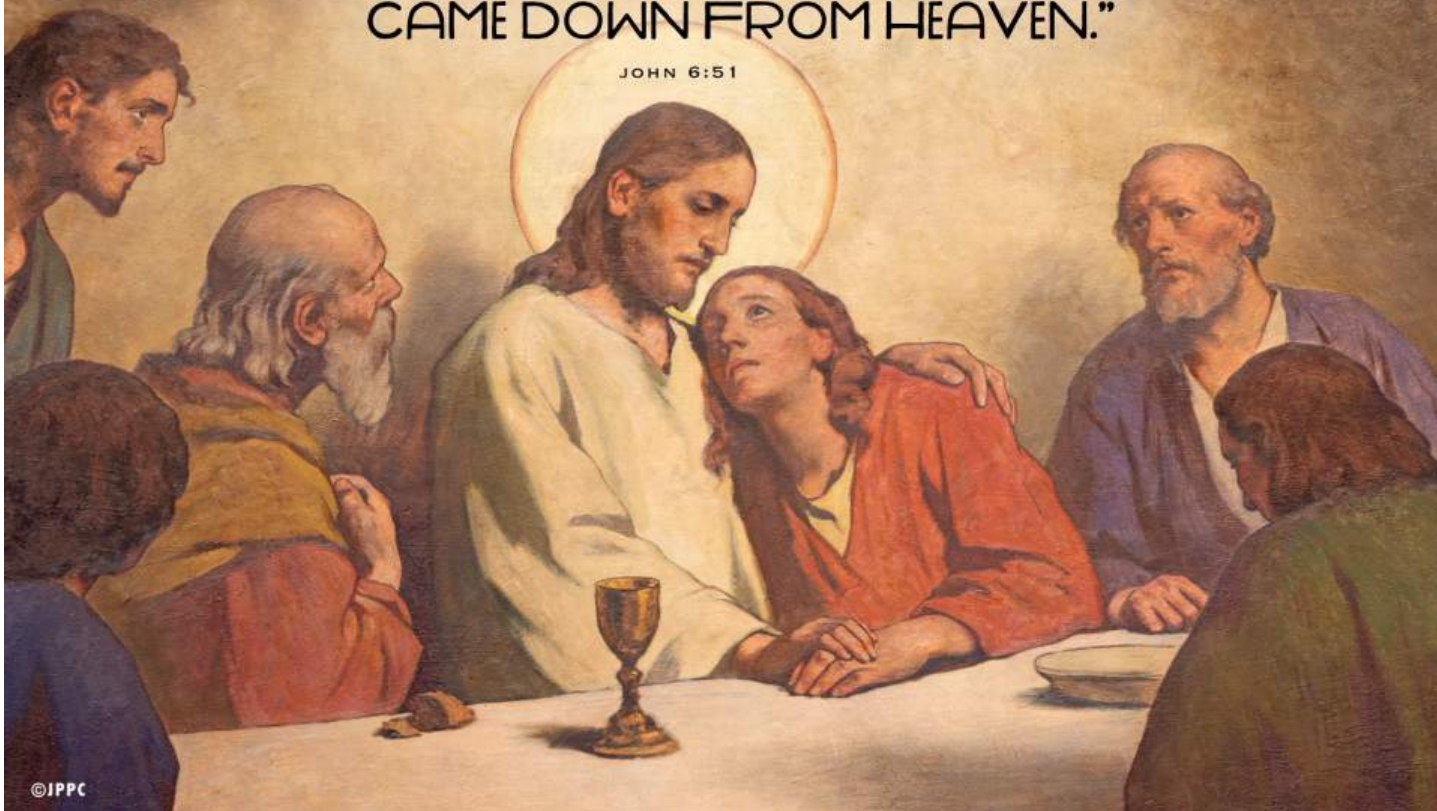

Have you been away from the active practice of your Catholic faith?

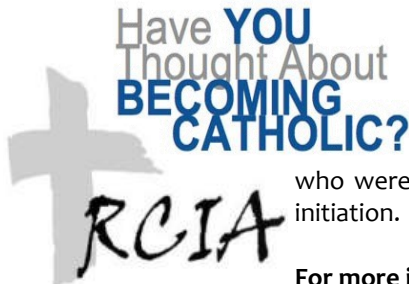
Would you like to feel more connected with your childhood faith or learn more about it as an adult? Consider attending the Awakening Faith Series.

Awakening Faith – Reconnecting with Your Catholic Faith is a small group process that helps inactive Catholics return to the Church. The group meets once a week for six weeks of conversation and socializing. The conversations are based on short, easy to read essays about spirituality, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, God’s mercy, the Mass, and the Church.

The meetings foster reflection, prayer, and honest sharing in a setting of hospitality and acceptance. A small community is formed and over the six weeks becomes a bridge to the larger Church community.

We can assist your return to the active practice of your faith and welcome you back to the Lord’s Table.

The RCIA process is one of conversion and spiritual formation for individuals interested in living the Christian life in the Catholic tradition. It is a time of prayer, reflection, study, faith sharing, discernment and participation in the life of the parish.

This process is for adults and children (age 7-17) who have never been baptized, those who were baptized in another faith tradition, or those who were baptized Catholic and seek full initiation.

Encountering Christ in the Homeless- PORT

Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you... Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Jn 6:53, 55-56.

Now that we have been nourished at this altar by the Bread of Life, we are sent to feed and care for our neighbor, respecting the rights that flow from his dignity as having been made in God's image. Everyone should look upon his neighbor as 'another self,' above all bearing in mind the means necessary for him to live his life with dignity. This duty to actively serve our neighbors becomes even more urgent when it involves the disadvantaged. CCC ¶¶ 1930-32.

One way to serve our neighbor is to heed the Lord's command to shelter the afflicted and the homeless, i.e. PORT. We are currently building leadership teams for each of our seven nights of service.

The Dinner Lead determines the menu and gathers volunteers who will cook and/or serve and/or clean up.

The Breakfast Bag Lead determines the contents of the breakfast/lunch bags that will be given to the guests upon their departure and gathers a team to assemble the bags.

The Night Lead coordinates with me and the host church on procedures and logistics, coordinates with the other two Leads to determine what food and other items we need to solicit from the Parish, and gathers volunteers who will work to check the guests in and out and to run the clothes closet. The Night Lead has overall responsibility for OLMC's service that particular night.

Please consider whether you are being called to this service and attend the meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 21 at the Carmel Center conference room.

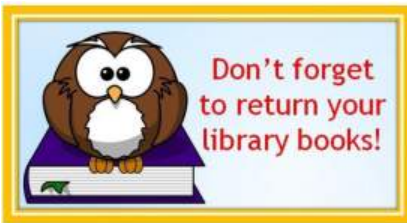
