Come and join us in this **new** study of the Beauty of the Catholic Faith.

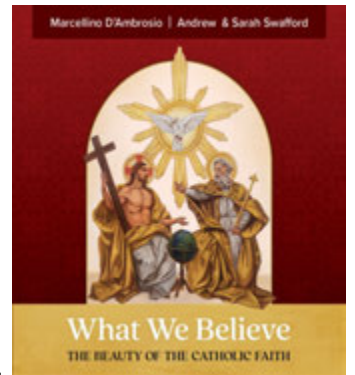
Discover who we are, what we believe and how we are called to live as Catholic Christians.

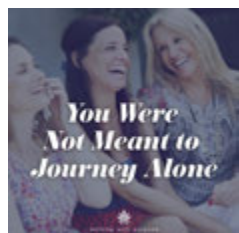

SOCIAL MINISTRY IS THE NATURAL RESULT OF GOD'S LOVE FOR US

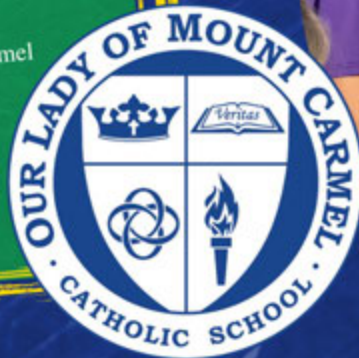

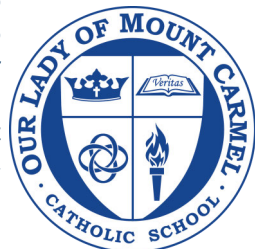
