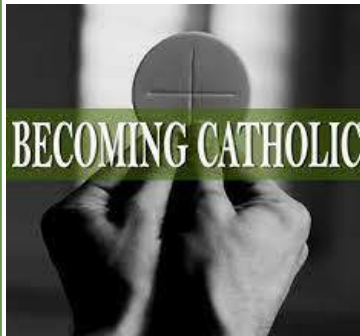

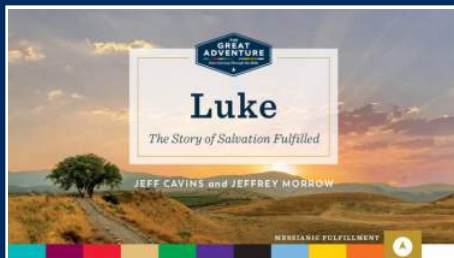

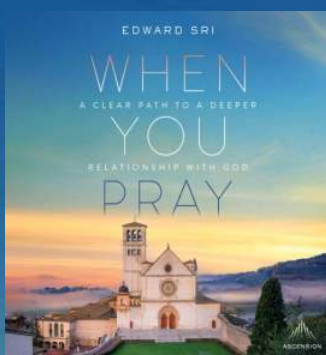
#### Luke: The Story of Salvation Fulfilled

# Mandatory Liturgy Training for using the new church

All training will take place in the new church.

**Lectors ~ Monday, September 23 at 7:00 p.m.**

The first half of this training will be an orientation on the new church for all current lectors. The second half will be training for anyone wishing to join the lector ministry. The lector ministry is open to all practicing Catholics sixteen years and older who have received the sacrament of confirmation. A good lector must be able to read the word of God at Mass articulately. If you are an articulate reader who feels called to this ministry or a current member of the lector ministry, plan to attend this training.

**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion ~ Tuesday, September 24 at 7:00 p.m.**

This training will be an orientation on the new church for all current extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion as well as a training opportunity for anyone else wishing to join the ministry. Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) assist the priest and deacon with distributing Holy Communion. To serve as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, one must be a practicing Catholic sixteen years or older who has received the sacrament of confirmation. The layout of the new church makes it necessary to utilize 4 or 5 EMHC per Sunday and holy day Mass so we will need the extra help.

**Ushers ~ Thursday, September 26 at 7:00 p.m.**

This training will be an orientation on the new church for all current ushers as well as a training opportunity for anyone interested in joining the usher ministry. Ushers welcome people as they arrive for Mass and assist with seating them. They also direct the Communion procession and help collect the weekly monetary offering. Ushers are needed for all weekend Masses, but especially for the 5 p.m. Masses on Saturday and Sunday. As we prepare to move back into the new church, please prayerfully consider serving as an usher.

**Altar Servers ~ Tuesday, October 1 at 6:30 p.m.**

This training will be an orientation on the new church for **current altar servers only**. If you are a current altar server, please plan to attend this training.
